



English

English will focus on traditional tales as a stimulus for the children. We will begin with Jack and the Beanstalk and then use a video called 'The clocktower' as a writing stimulus. The children will be immersed in story telling language and will use a story making technique to retell many traditional tales.

Mathematics

In Maths we will begin by counting, reading and writing numbers to 100 in numerals and words. The children will then be introduced to place value- partitioning 2 digit numbers into tens and ones. This will allow children to compare numbers using < and >. Children will need to count in steps of 2, 3, 5 and 10. We will also cover addition and subtraction within 100 and adding three numbers together.

Science

In Science, we will be looking carefully at plants. Naming the parts will focus on our monarchy and in of a plant, watching plants grow and particular the Queen.
