

English

This term we will be reading the delightful *Beegu* and *Bob the Man on the Moon*. We will be building comprehension skills through medium of film, using the animation *Way Back Home*. Closer to home, as part of the whole school Somerset Folk Tales Week, we shall be retelling the story, *The Pixies of Withypool*. In phonics, we will be learning alternative pronunciations and spellings.

Art and Design

We will be designing, creating and evaluating a moving picture.

History

In history we will learn about a significant figure from living memory and a significant event: Neil Armstrong and the moon landing.

Mathematics

In maths we will be continuing with our mental maths challenges to boost our recall of number pairs. This will help us with missing number problems for example:  $6 = \_\_\_ + 2$ . We will be developing addition and subtraction skills within 20 using the part part whole and bar models.

We will use resources like Numicon, counters, straws and number lines to help us learn how to add and subtract and record our findings by writing number sentences using symbols.

We will discuss the different types of work people do. We will think about our strengths as learners, how we learn and achieve goals.

We will be sorting and describing materials by their properties. We will be building our scientific language and observational skills.
