# **Mathematics**

We will be looking at fractions – halves, quarters, thirds and three quarters, equivalence and counting in fractions. We will then go on to look at height and length in measurement looking at units of measurement in a practical context.

## Science

The focus for Science this term is the needs of humans and animals. We will look at how humans and animals need water, food and air to survive. We will then look at healthy eating, the importance of exercise and keeping clean.

We will be focusing on local Geography. We will look at maps and directions on a compass. We will then map a route in our school grounds.
