Some of you may have seen our new caretaker on site this week. We are very pleased to welcome Mr Janaka Mudiliage at Westfield.

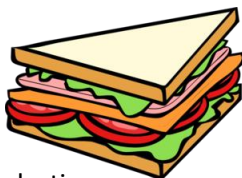


Parent Governors
