Year 6 Cross Country

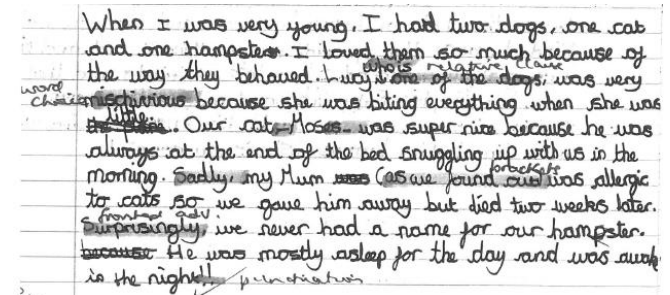

School Hours

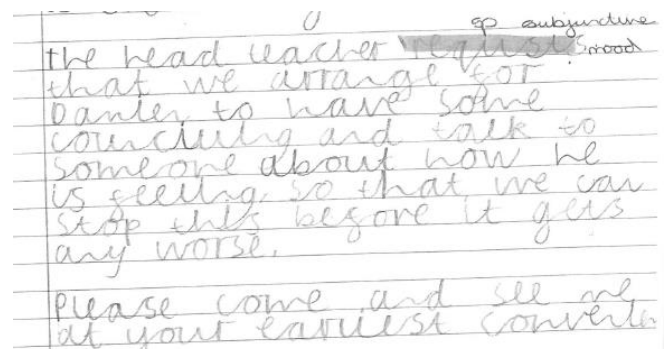
