Can you park on zig zag lines outside school?



Basically. No.

But it seems only 17% of people know that stopping on zig-zags is banned at school-run times. While it may be well known that you can't park on yellow zigzag lines, you also can't wait or even stop momentarily to drop off or pick up passengers. The Yellow Zig Zag markings identify a Controlled Zone, within which, parking or stopping of a vehicle is not permitted.

This is to ensure the safety of children, your children!

If you stop your vehicle for the crossing patrol, that is fine, as you are in the flow of traffic.

The Neighbourhood Policing Team at Radstock Police Station will be patrolling, and any vehicles seen parking or stopping at the kerb, within the markings, will be reported for the offence.

Radstock Neighbourhood Policing Team, have issued this message to hopefully educate parents and carers who transport children to and from school, to encourage them to park safety and legally.
