Dear Parents

The Governing Body of Westfield Primary School has made the decision to change the way in which parents currently communicate with the school through its Facebook page. As a result most comments will no longer be authorised and posted onto the school site, which is also in line with MNSP policy. The following points were raised as areas of concern:

- · Is the school Facebook page the appropriate channel to raise concerns or express certain views?
- · Would private and confidential discussions with school be more appropriate? If so contact school to discuss any concerns you may have.
- · Notifying absences must be done through contact with the school office, either by phone or email.
- · Breakfast Club and After School Club bookings also need to be organised through the school office, preferably with appropriate notice.
- · The school must not be notified of collection arrangements through social media as these may not be sanctioned and as a result put your child at immediate risk.
- · It was also noted that many of the queries were only relevant to the individual and not suitable for public posting.
- · No member of staff should be approached through any form of social media or instant messaging to comply with new GDPR regulations.
- · Many of the queries are also easily answered through reading the school's weekly newsletter or website.

The school is looking to replace the messaging with a secure system at the start of the New Year which will enable parents to contact the school on a one to one basis, similar to texting or emailing. We will notify you of developments in due course.

Christmas Dinner

Our school Christmas lunch will be on 18th December. This will need to be pre ordered and paid for on School Grid (free for Reception and KS1 children) by the end of today. We welcome children to come to school on that day wearing their normal school uniform with the exception of a jumper/cardigan. They are welcome to replace this with a Christmas Jumper!

Christmas Church Service

Tuesday 17th December

Due to the size of the church and the number of pupils at school it is simply not possible to do this all together. We have therefore decided to run two identical services, with half the school in each service. This will not be done as Key Stages, as it affects the service, but rather as one class per year group in each service. This allows us to run a nativity/tableau arrangement with Reception, and doubles the opportunities for pupils to contribute.
