If your child was born between 01 September 2017 and 31 August 2018, you should have received information from Bath and North East Somerset asking you to apply for a space in a reception class for September 2022. The local authority is encouraging parent/carers to apply online through the authority's website. On the website you can access both the online application facility and also view a copy of the 2022/23 Primary Admissions booklet. Alternatively, parent/carers can download and print the reception transfer application form from the website or if they prefer, they can ask for a copy of the application form to be issued to them by contacting the Admissions & Transport Unit. All information booklets, forms and the online application facility have been available on the website from 10 September 2021.

## Is your child eligible for Free School Meals - EBB?

Please register your child (including those in Reception, Year 1 and Year 2) for free school meals if you are in receipt of qualifying benefits. Registration will attract additional funding for our school for Pupil Premium (£1,320 per Primary pupil). You can register your entitlement for Free School Meals - Eligible by Benefit (EBB) if you have children who attends a school in Bath and North East Somerset, and you are in receipt of any of the qualifying benefits listed below. Qualifying benefits for Free School Meals:

· Universal Credit (provided you have an annual net earned income of no more than £7,400, as assessed by earnings from up to three of your most recent assessment periods)

Income Support

Income Based Jobseekers Allowance

 Income Related Employment and Support Allowance · Child Tax Credit, without any Working Tax Credit, and an annual household income (as assessed by Her Majesty's Revenue and Customs) that is not more than £16,190

 Run-on Working Tax Credit which is only paid for 4 weeks after you STOP qualifying for Working Tax Credit

Guaranteed Element of State Pension Credit

## How to register – just call!

Call Ruth in the school office, you will need you to tell her your National Insurance Number when you call. Please note that the Local Authority will check your eligibility to qualifying benefits on your behalf using the DFE online Free School Meal Eligibility Checking Service.
