Who will complete their calendar?

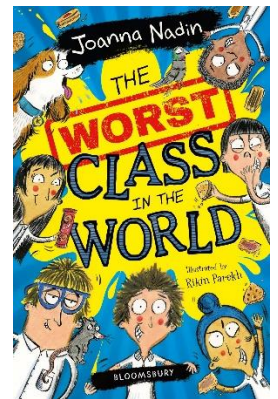


Panto
