Earrings

Times tables

Following a pupil survey we have decided to move our times tables home learning onto the Doodle platform. As a school we are currently using Doodle maths and have seen positive engagement from all year groups and some fantastic progress in maths. We will not be renewing our Times Table Rockstars subscription next week and will now use Doodle Tables instead.

Your login for Doodle tables will be the same login as Doodle maths. If you are using a smart device you will need to download the separate Doodle tables app or you can select Doodle tables from the Doodle learning platform on a laptop or computer.

Your child will complete the placement assessment over the next few weeks in school and your class teacher will inform you when your child is ready to access the app from home.

Year 3 sleepover - Friday 10th June

To prepare our Year 3 children for their first school residential in Year 4, we hold a Year 3 sleepover each year. This year we would like to invite Year 3 to sleep at school on Friday 10th June. Children may return to school at 5.30pm for an evening meal and games and fun on the school field. Children are encouraged to attend to develop their independence if they are not used to sleeping away from home and we always have lots of fun (and very tired children AND staff the following day!)

Year 4 camp - May 2022

Just a gentle reminder to keep on top of your payment plan for Greatwood camp in May. If you are following the plan you should have paid £100 by the end of January, leaving three monthly payments of £30 for February, March and April. If you need to check on your payment plan please call the school office.

Playground one way system

Please use playground one system when dropping off & collecting your child from school.



At home time please can pupils NOT run over the new mound on the field as it has been planted with bulbs and wildflowers!

Dogs

Please can you **NOT** bring any dogs onto school site! This is a school policy and protects all of our pupils.

Covid isolation period

If you have COVID-19, you should stay at home while you're infectious to others.

This can be for up to 10 days from when your symptoms start. Many people will no longer be infectious to others after 5 days.

You can do a rapid lateral flow test from 5 days after your symptoms started (or the day you had the test if you do not have symptoms) and another the next day.

If both tests are negative and you do not have a high temperature, you're less likely to pass COVID-19 to others and you can go back to your normal routine.

If your test result is positive on day 5, you can carry on doing rapid lateral flow tests every day until you get 2 negative test results in a row.



