Weather Guidelines

With the warmer weather that has arrived please may we remind you to provide your children with sun hats. We recommend the 'once a day' sun cream and would be grateful if this could be applied in the morning before school. If your child needs to bring sun cream into school, it must be labelled with your child's name and given to the class teacher who can lock it away securely until it is needed. Sunglasses can only be worn if they meet the government guidelines and have the safety mark.

Sunglasses

Pupils must wear sunglasses with UV protection to shield their eyes. Wrap-around sunglasses are especially good for children. Sunglasses should have a CE mark and British Standard mark. Plastic frames and lenses only unless prescription sunglasses
