School Uniform

- Shoes – Black Shoes

PE Uniform

In order to maintain consistency and high standards across the school, please be reminded of the expectations for PE uniform. All items should be plain and free from logos or brand names, other than the official school logo.

Indoor PE Kit

- Black or White Trainers

Outdoor PE Kit (colder months)

- Plain Black, Grey, or Blue Tracksuit, Sweatshirt, or Leggings

PE kits are considered an essential part of school equipment and should be brought into school every Monday morning and remain in school until Friday afternoon, when they can be taken home to be washed.

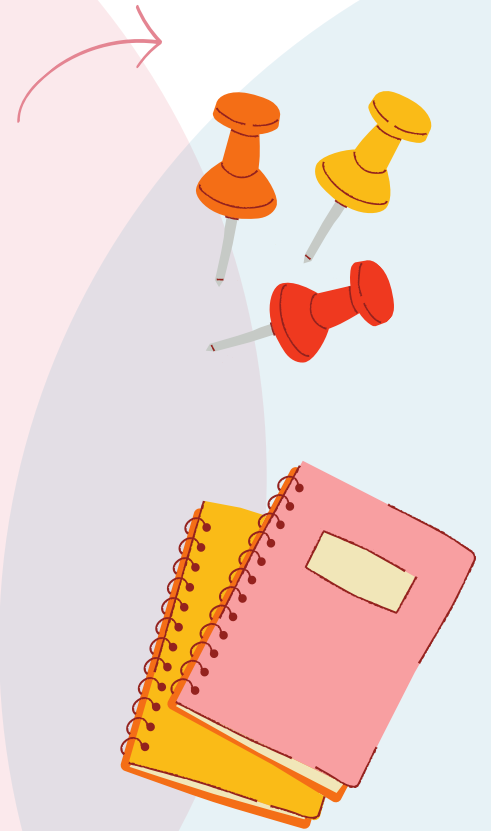
