Home-School Agreement

- Communicate with families clearly through newsletters, email, and our school website.
- Respond to communications from parents and carers in line with school policies and within a reasonable timeframe.
- Encourage good attendance and work with families to resolve any concerns.
- Offer opportunities for parents and carers to engage with and contribute to school life.

As Parents/Carers, I/we will:

- Ensure my child attends school regularly, on time, and inform the school promptly if they are absent.
- Ensure my child wears the correct uniform and brings the required equipment and PE kit.
- Support the school's expectations for high standards of behaviour, both in school and in the wider community.
- Encourage my child to try their best and take pride in their learning.
- Support my child with their homework by providing encouragement, guidance, and a suitable environment for study.
- Ensure my child completes homework on time and raise any difficulties with teachers.
- Inform the school of any issues or concerns that might affect my child's learning or behaviour.
- Communicate respectfully with school staff and contact the appropriate member of staff where possible.
- Understand that staff respond to communication during core school hours, and that replies outside of those times cannot be expected.
- Read and follow the school's policies.

- Treat all members of the school community with courtesy and respect.
- Attend parent meetings and work in partnership with the school to achieve the best outcomes for my child.
- Read all school communications and respond when required.
