Food items need to be non-perishable.

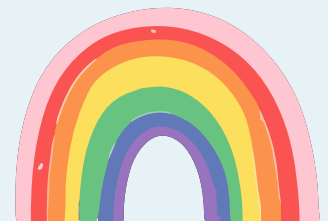
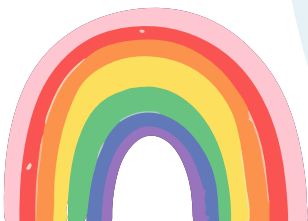
All items in new condition and in date please.

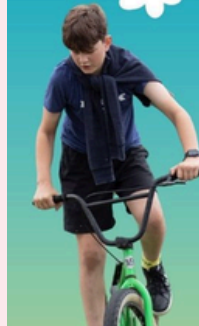
