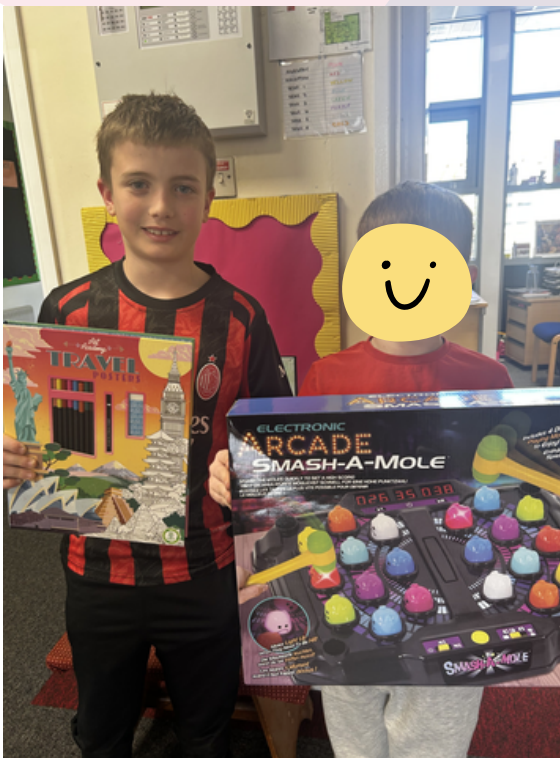


## Lunchtime Award Winners Term 4

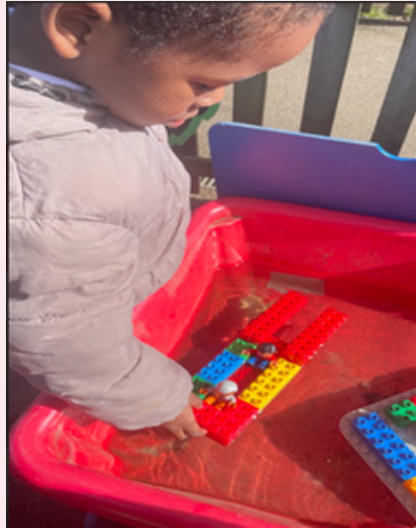

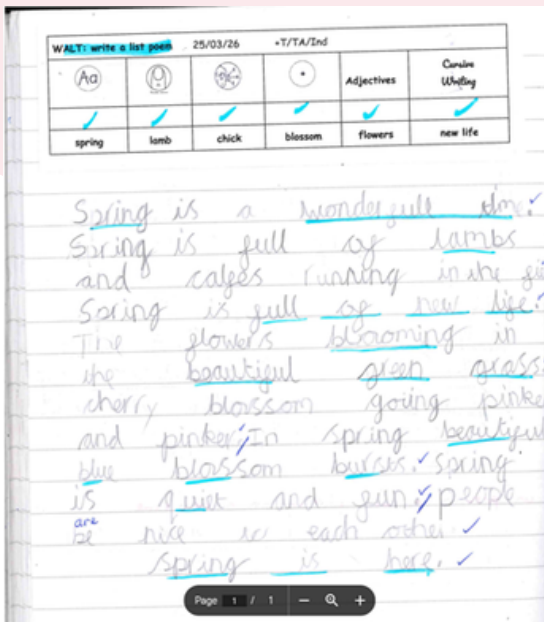


# Last Term in Year 1/2



Last term Year 1/2's had fun exploring maps in art.

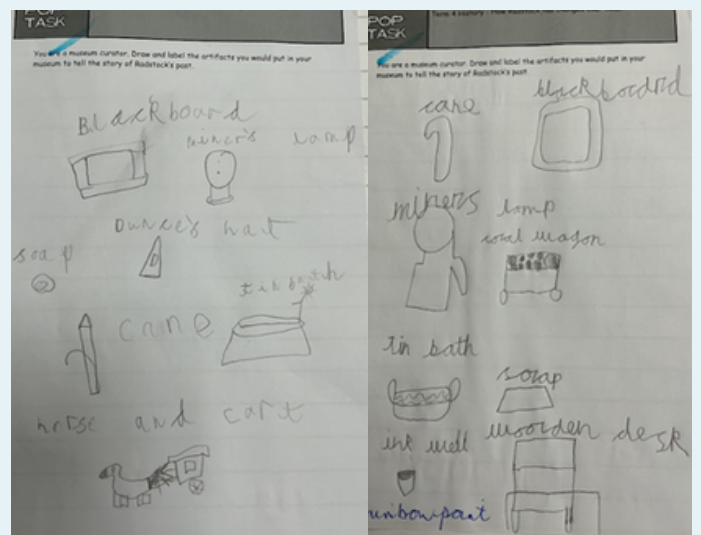
We made the classrooms into art galleries to display all the different pieces of work. There were relief maps, abstract maps and printed maps.
