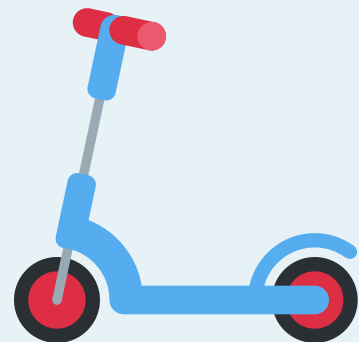
Reading Raffle & Doodle Maths winners – Term 5

This term in Year 5

It has been action-packed in Year 5! From the heat of the kitchen to the legendary battles of early Britain, the children have been fully immersed in their learning. Here is a look at what we have been up to.

Our Design and Technology lessons took a delicious turn as we practiced our chopping, sautéing, and seasoning skills. The children worked brilliantly to cook a lentil bolognese. Not only did they learn about healthy, plant-based alternatives, but they also focused on the importance of food hygiene and safety in the kitchen.



In Art, we have been exploring the world of Cai Guo-Qiang, an artist famous for using gunpowder and "explosion events" to create stunning installation art. While we didn't use real explosives, the children captured that same energy and movement in their own installation pieces, experimenting with texture and scale to create a "wow" factor in their mini art galleries.

This term in Year 5



We have been getting to grips with angles this week! The children have been learning to: identify acute, obtuse, and right angles, use protractors with precision to measure and draw angles, and calculate missing angles on a straight line.

We've also completed some Geography Fieldwork this term. We loved observing the modes of transport used in our community. We spent three sessions outside surveying the road for different vehicles that travelled past. Many drivers even gave us a wave!
